BIOGRAPHY:

Glen Roberts is the Director of the U.S. Department of Commerce's U.S. Commercial Service Export Assistance Center in Bakersfield, California. Gaining new markets to understanding the payment process, Glen guides these small to medium sized enterprises along their way into the world of exports.

He was also the Deputy Team Leader of the Renewable Energy and Alternative Fuels for the U.S. Commercial Service National Energy Team for two years. Glen is currently assisting companies with over 20million dollars in export assistance.

He is also responsible for setting up an intern program in Kern County, which, trains the interns in the basics of exporting including research and then places each trained intern in a small to medium size company for assistance. To date 34% of the interns have been hired on full time.

Prior to the Department of Commerce, Glen was the manager of an international freight forwarder office located in San Diego. Freight forwarding gave Glen hands-on experience of collecting payment through various methods and moving goods around the world including alternative fuels.

Most of his experience has been in hydraulic fracturing treatments, cementing services, coiled tubing and acidizing matrix treatments.
